Abstract

The speaker will describe some of her research with Native North Americans and other Indigenous Peoples on the ways in which they are reclaiming a heritage which had been overtaken by wider nations that grew up around them. A global movement has been building up for some time, supported by the United Nations, and aspects of this will be illustrated, with photographs. Hendry will also examine some of the methods needed to look at such a phenomenon, and the ambiguity with which her own discipline of anthropology is regarded in this field.
