

# Applying for Makeup Examination due to Extracurricular Activities

**Students of all years** can apply for a makeup examination if they were unable to take a **final examination at the end of the semester** or **an additional examination approved by the faculty council** (midterm examination etc.) due to illness or unavoidable reasons (for “additional examination approved by the faculty council,” see the message board of your affiliated faculty or ask at the office of your affiliated faculty or the Center for Academic Affairs on either campus).

■ If **extracurricular activities** **[see below for applicable activities]** is the reason you are unable to attend the above examination, **you need to complete all of the following procedures 1 to 4 before the examination to be eligible for a makeup examination.** So **allow enough time** to prepare the necessary documents in time.

1. Issue the Application for Makeup Examination form (①) from the certificate issuing machine, fill in required fields and have it checked at the office of your affiliated faculty or the Center for Academic Affairs on either campus (makeup examination fee is 1,000 yen per subject).

2. Bring the Application for Makeup Examination form and a **document certifying the reason of your unavailability for the examination concerned** [see below] to the Department of Students Sports Support or the Department of Student Support Services, Imadegawa Campus in the case of a sports activity, and to the Department of Student Support Services on either campus in the case of a cultural or academic activity.

↓

3. After reviewing the documents, a “**Certificate (Review of Application for Makeup Examination due to Extracurricular Activities)**” (②) will be issued if it is deemed eligible for makeup examination.

4. Bring the above documents ① and ② to the office of your affiliated faculty or the Center for Academic Affairs on either campus.

**<Complete all of the above before the scheduled date of examination concerned>**

## **<Applicable Extracurricular Activities>**

Participation in a nationwide competition (including student-only event), international competition/match, or a competition in western Japan or Kansai region that is the precondition for participation in such nationwide or international competition, by a club officially recognized by the university.

**<What is a document certifying the reason of your unavailability for the examination concerned?>**

International competition/match ⇒ a letter of invitation to the university issued by the federation concerned

Domestic competition/match ⇒ summary of the event and a document objectively state the applicant’s participation (if no such document is available, a

certificate by the manager (supervisor) of the club), etc.
